He was the sixth bishop of Antioch.

Both he and Athenagoras were converted by reading the scriptures.

He wrote a letter Autolycus with the hopes of converting him.

In the third part, Theophilus wrote about how Christianity was superior to paganism. What message does this convey to us? It should convey a message regarding the distinctiveness of the church. We are in the world, but not of the world (Rom.12:1-2). Jesus prayed that we would be "sanctified by His Word..." (Jn.17:16-17).

- Born 85 A.D. and the son of an elder in Pontus
- A wealthy ship owner
- Arrived in Rome 138 A.D.
- He was very generous and influential man
- His Biblical Views:
 - Thought the church was to legalistic
 - He rejected the value of the O.T. and viewed God differently in the O.T.
 - He only respected the Apostle Paul
- The church at Rome withdrew from him in 144 A.D.
- He wrote "Antithesis" or "Contradictions"
- He believed Paul's and Luke's writings as being credible
- He created the Marcionite church
- He created his own Canon (The Marcion Bible), 11 books
